SEAFAIR KAYAK RULES

ALL COMPETITORS MUST HAVE A KAYAK AND AN APPROVED LIFEJACKET TO COMPETE!

Must have a type 1, 2, 3, or 5 coast guard approved life jacket on or onboard.

SAFETY: All Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and United States Coast Guard regulations shall be followed at all times. In addition, each participant shall be required to comply with these regulations such as equipment and proper life jacket. Anyone found not in compliance shall be disqualified.

PARTICIPATION: All participants must have a kayak approved by race committee (no motors of any kind permitted, i.e., trolling motor). **No outside assistance permitted.**

Kayak General Racing Rules: **1.** Lifejacket with attached whistle to be worn at all times while in the kayak – Contestants will have a number placard affixed to the back of PFD which must remain in place. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

2. Kayak must be sit on top, one-man paddle powered, 16ft. or less.

3. A competitor shall only use the paddle to propel the kayak forward during the race. No outside assistance from boat wakes, sails, clothing designed to catch wind, or any other speed device not considered the norm to kayak racing is allowed.

4. Race course will be from the South end of Little Bay by Festival Grounds to the North end by the Key Allegro bridge and back. There will be pylons (buoys) at the beginning and end of the race that have to be navigated. There will be a penalty for missing a pylon. At the North end, contestants will receive a “object of the day” which must be presented at the finish line

5. There will be a mandatory contestants meeting one hour prior to the race. **CHECK-IN TIME:** 10am

QUALIFICATIONS: The Race Participants must be between the ages of 15+ yrs. of age. The Race Committee has the right to deny anyone from participating in race at any time. Participants must be of good fitness and health and must disclose any pre-conditions that may disqualify them from the race.

LAUNCH: Launch will be at the South end of Little Bay by Festival Grounds. Launching from other locations is not permitted. Doing so will result in disqualification. Any ramp fees, park fees, access fees, etc. are the responsibility of the Race Participant.

RACE TIME: Official Race start will be at 11am, October 13. The race will end when the last participant crosses the finish line. The awards will be announced and given between 12:30pm – 1pm, October 13.

PROTEST: The Race Official decisions are final. Race Participants who argue with tournament officials will be disqualified at the Race officials' discretion.

AWARDS: The Race Official decisions are final. There will be race awards for the first 3 places.

CHANGES IN RULES: These rules may change without notice.
